NATIONAL SHERIFFS' ASSOCIATION SUPPORTS THE SAFECOM EMERGENCY RESPONSE COUNCIL PLAIN LANGUAGE STATEMENT

- WHEREAS, the scope of law enforcement services continues to increase and requires communication with multiple and diverse law enforcement agencies; and
- WHEREAS, following the events of 9/11, effective communication systems among emergency responders became necessary; and
- WHEREAS, as a result, SAFECOM was established in the Office of Interoperability and Compatibility (OIC) within the Department of Homeland Security (DHS); and
- WHEREAS, SAFECOM assists Federal, state, local, and tribal emergency response agencies with interoperable communications issues; and
- WHEREAS, SAFECOM provides such assistance in the forms of research, development, testing and evaluation, guidance, tools and templates; and
- WHEREAS, the SAFECOM Emergency Response Council (ERC) is composed of Federal, state, local, and tribal emergency response agencies and governments and works to develop best practices in emergency response and communication; and
- WHEREAS, SAFECOM Emergency Response Council (ERC) examined the issue of coded communication among emergency responses versus plain language responses and developed a statement of support for plain language; and
- WHEREAS, the SAFECOM Emergency Response Council (ERC) Plain Language Statement reads "We support radio practices that minimize or eliminate coded substitutions for English"; and now
- THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED that the National Sheriffs' Association (NSA) supports SAFECOM Emergency Response Council (ERC) Plain Language Statement.
